**An environmental expert says Eskom is operating on an outdated model that is heavily impacting nature and consumer's pockets.**

David Hallows from NGO Groundwork made presentations at the Durban public hearings into Eskom's application for a 15% electricity tariff hike.

Hallows says every part of Eskom's operation - from mining to lack of replenishment, to global warming contributions through the burning of coal - kills the environment.

He says while the power giant knows this very well - it still chooses to operate on this model due to heavy investments made in the name of profits.
